## 1. PURPOSE & SCOPE

- 1.1. This policy sets the framework for the acceptance, management, and reporting of donations and funding to ensure that all financial support aligns with the MSU's commitment to sustainability, ethical principles, and environmental stewardship. The policy aims to ensure that contributions to the university do not conflict with its mission, values, or long-term sustainability goals.
- 1.2. This policy applies to all departments, faculties, and units of the university, including all forms of donations, sponsorships, and financial contributions from individuals, organizations, or foundations.

## 2. Policy Statement:

MSU is committed to promoting sustainability and ethical practices in all areas of its operations, including the acceptance of donations and funding. MSU will only accept funds from sources that align with the following criteria:

### 3.1 Environmental and Social Responsibility:


- Donations or funding from entities involved in activities with significant negative environmental impacts (such as fossil fuel extraction, deforestation, or large-scale pollution) will not be accepted.
- The university will prioritize funding from organizations that demonstrate a commitment to sustainability, clean energy, responsible resource management, and environmentally-friendly practices.

### 3.2 Human Rights and Ethical Practices:

- Donations or funding from organizations involved in activities that violate human rights, labor laws, or promote discrimination, exploitation, or inequality will be declined.
- Contributions from entities linked to unethical business practices (e.g., corruption, child labor, modern slavery) will not be considered.

### 3.3 Transparency and Accountability:

- Donors must provide transparent and verifiable information regarding the source of their funds. The university will conduct due diligence to ensure that the funds do not originate from illegal or unethical activities.
